There, ruler Otto constructed a modest neogothic palace for Queen Amalia, his spouse. The building is reminiscent of the Hohenschwangau Castle in Bavaria, which was constructed for King Otto's brother, Maximilian II. The castle is known as the Queen's Tower since there is just one tower. The Serpieri family purchased the estate following King Otto's abdication, and they now possess it. On the property, there is a winery and dairy farm. "Tour la Reine" refers to the wines that are bottled on the estate (French for Queen's Tower).
